### **Internet Exercise – 1b (Teacher Reference)**

- Use [www.bing.com/maps/](http://www.bing.com/maps/) and show students WHERE Hawaii is and where HCDB is, then where my home (via address) is – use bird’s eye view. Use similar for California School for the Deaf – Riverside (taken from worksheet 1a).

- Review worksheet 1b (and instructions – esp. end). Discuss about Deaf Education worldwide and ask if ALL Deaf use ASL... Show Deaf School country locations and websites for [Newfoundland School for the Deaf](#), [Meiseigakuen School for the Deaf](#) (Tokyo), [Royal School Manchester](#) (England), and [The Deaf Society of New South Wales](#) (Australia).

- Go to <http://www.google.com>, search world deaf schools
  - Click on [World Deaf Schools Links](#), click on Deaf Schools for the Deaf in North America (and show Canada list), followed by Australia, Japan, Korea, United Kingdom (England), other Countries (show Thailand & explain that many web pages have changed so “links” don’t work now, show others – Cambodia & first India school...)
  - Use [www.bing.com/maps/](http://www.bing.com/maps/) and show students WHERE each country and area is (especially in comparison to Hawaii) – Canada, Australia, Japan, Korea, UK (England), Thailand, Cambodia, and India.
  - Have students follow worksheet directions and “visit” 7 Schools for the Deaf, their website and record info on worksheet.
